Interested in becoming an EPS Parent Class Reps 2019?

An EPS class rep is the point of contact for and distributor of school information within your child's class. As a rep you will be required to attend 4 P&F meetings per year, 1 each term, which are brief, informative and fun. These meetings are held on a Tuesday or Wednesday evening and run for about an hour. During the meeting you will have the opportunity to contribute, if you wish, to some social school decisions and fund raising ideas, as well as keep up to date with important school information and market updates etc. These meetings provide much of the information you will be feeding back to your class parents. As reps you also organise at least two class functions/catch ups for parents and children in your class over the year; More if you wish and feel particularly social! These can be as simple as a play on the sports oval after school, to a parent's only dinner, your call entirely, and there's always another rep around who can help you make a decision if you need. This is a great way to assist our families in getting to know each other and feel a part of our wonderful community and is always well received. Very exciting news for Elwood College with the commencement of the site work in January for their new building, a three storey modular classroom block, with construction to then continue offsite. Students will be able to move into the new building on the first day of Term 2. This classroom block was funded by the Victorian Labor government in the 2018-19 State budget. The building will be situated at the end of our new building and is part of the continuing upgrade and modernisation of Elwood College.

Preparation involves the children attending a series of weekly after-school workshops over several weeks. The sacramental program is open to children from grade three upwards. If you are seeking the first sacrament, Baptism, Christine is also able to assist you here. Older children in grade six, who have not made any sacraments can join a separate program where all sacraments are conferred at once. Please note that we begin Reconciliation for grade three children very early in term one of 2019 so interested families need to contact Christine as soon as possible.
