*Uniform, packing bags and lunchbox practice.


*Visit the school often.

On the first day, bring your child to the classroom, please stay, take a few photos & when you feel the time is right say see you later.


If your child is upset, please stay a little longer. Sometimes passing your child to a teacher and quickly heading off is best.

settled.


First Day of School
