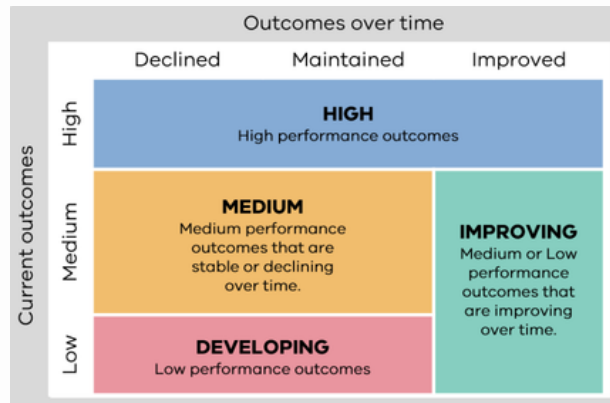


2026 RESULTS

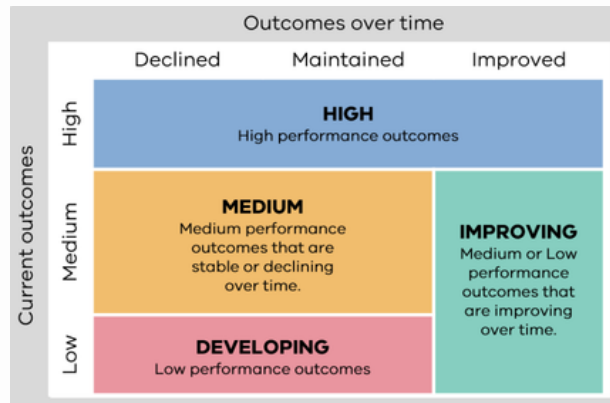
